

Types of Car Washes

1. Self Serve-The car washer will clean their own vehicle using Brush, wands etc. The car wash supplies all types of cleaning solutions for the automobile, such as cleaning, waxing, spot free, wheel cleaning. Many self serve washes also have one or two bays for automatic machine washes.
2. In Bay Automatic Washes- The car washer will decide which type of wash he/she wants, enter the information in a Machine teller, that will automatically select the type of wash purchase. The driver Pulls in the bay at a designated spot, and the automatic car wash equipment washes the car using different cycles and wash solutions. Many In Bay Automatic washes also have a automatic dryer for the car when the automatic cycle is completed. The

automatic dryer is normally stationed at the end of the bay the automatic washing equipment is located.

3. Express Exterior Car Wash- The car wash driver enters the bay after selecting the type of wash desired. Normally the car is guided by the tunnel on a conveyor belt. In some cases, the car wash provides a towel drying after the Express Car Wash. Normally, the car wash offers free vacs.

4. Flex Car Wash-This wash operates exactly like the Express Exterior Car Wash but offers types of detail services, such as waxing, tinting etc

5. Full Service Car Wash- This wash offers many services such as Flex Car Wash but also may include Oil Changing and more. Normally there is a building with a waiting area for the customer to wait while services are being performed.
